The institution provides limited financial assistance to general category students with good academic record. Such students are required to submit the application to the Students aid fund committee with in time frame.

IV. Library:

Our college has a rich Library having excellent collection of Reference books, Text books, Periodicals, Newspapers, Magazines, Diwali issues and Competitive Exam, books. Students should make use of library books for updating their knowledge improving all-round personality to be competitive in their field/discipline/ subject. It is expected that they should make the best use of Study Room. Our College also subscribe N List Journal and provides password to all teachers and students.

a. General rules:

1. Every student should have valid college Identity Card in the college premises and should be presented on demand.

2. Books, periodicals, magazines should be handled with great and utmost care. Any attempt to damage, deface or disfigure or tearing pages will be treated as misconduct and strictly dealt with.

b. Reading room rules:

1. A complete and pin drop silence to be maintained in study Room and Library premises.

2. Books, Magazines issued in the study room should be studied there only. Students are not permitted to take them outside the reading room / study room.

c. Home issue:

1. Books / Text books will be issued for home reading for a week.

3. Late returning of the book may cause a fine of Re. 1/- per day or Rs. 5/- per week.

4. Defacing or disfiguring of the book will cause the fine equal to the present cost of the book.

2. Parents are requested to contact the teacher in-charge of the class, Head of the Department or the Principal at least once in a term.
3. The college shall not be responsible for any loss on account of a lack of minimum essential attendance.
4. Continuous absence for lectures and tests etc. will be treated very seriously.
5. Students who fail to maintain his/her minimum attendance on account of long illness or any other reason should apply to the Principal in writing and get permission.

*Prohibition of Ragging / Sexual Harassment

Ragging is prohibited and is cognizable offence as per rules of the Government of Maharashtra. Serious action will be taken by the authorities for any form of ragging/ goonies. WHAT CONSTITUTES RAGGING?

Ragging constitutes one or more of any of the following acts:

- a) Any conduct by any students of students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of leasing treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student.
- b) Indulging in rowdy or indiscipline activates by any students or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student.

- c) Asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student.
- d) Any act by a senior student that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher.
- e) Any act of physical extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a fresher or any other student by students.
- f) Any act of physical abuse including all variants of it: sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, stripping, forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily harm or any other
- g) Danger to health or person. Any act of physical extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a fresher or any other student by student.
- h) Any act or abuse by spoken words, emails, post, public insults which would also include deriving prevented pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating in the discomfiture to fresher or any other student.
- i) Any act or abuse by spoken words, emails, post, public insults which would also include deriving prevented pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating in the discomfiture to fresher or any other student.
- j) Any act that affects the mental health and self-confidence of a fresher or any other student with or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher or any other student.
